We will be talking about the importance of spending time together with friends and family and focusing on showing RESPECT to others and ourselves, which will support our Personal, Social and Emotional development.

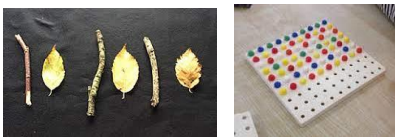
Literacy

Through our focus texts, which include: What can you see in Autumn?, The Very Helpful Hedgehog, Owl Babies, The Gruffalo and The Christmas Story; we will be developing a love of books and stories.

During phonics sessions we will be learning about and listening to instrumental sounds.

Mathematics

Children will be continuing their learning about placing, arranging, sorting, grouping and counting. They will be consolidating their learning about the values of numbers 1-3 and they will be exploring repeating pattern indoors and in the natural world.



Understanding the World

We will be looking at the outside environment and discussing any seasonal changes that we see.

We will also be learning about Christmas and our traditions.



THE LOCAL AREA

We will be going to the local woods on an Autumn walk. We will also be having a visit to school from Santa!

Art in focus

The children will continue their learning about 'Abstract Art' (Expressionism) and colour mixing, they will also be learning how to mix the colours of Autumn represented by natural objects.
