



# NURSERY AUTUMN TERM



## Autumn - term curriculum

In Nursery this half term, alongside our mini project about colour mixing, we will be starting another project about 'Me, Myself, My World'. We will be welcoming new friends and focussing on KINDNESS to others and ourselves, which will support our Personal, Social and Emotional development.

### Literacy

Through our focus texts, which include: The Colour Monster goes to School, All are Welcome, The Colour Monster, In Every House on Every Street and Julian is a Mermaid; we will be developing a love of books and stories.

During phonics sessions we will be learning and listening to sounds around us and in different environments such as home, farmyard and outdoors.

### Mathematics

Children will be learning how to count, place, arrange, sort, group and classify loose parts, blocks, and a variety of other objects by type, size, colour, shape. They will also be learning the values of numbers 1-3 and how these are built.



### Understanding the World

We will harvest the beans and potatoes that we planted last term and plant bulbs ready for Spring.

We will also be learning about who we are as individuals, our families and where we live.



## THE LOCAL AREA

We will be going to Maws Craft Centre at Jackfield to create our own Abstract Art tile. We will also be visiting Madeley Library for a story and singing session.

### Art in focus

The children will be learning about 'Abstract Art' (Expressionism) and they will be looking at artists' work.



We will be trying a variety of techniques to create our own abstract artwork.
