

**We are travelling back to Ancient Greece!**

**Reading:** To discover where reading will take us, our class story book is "The Adventures of Odysseus" written by Hugh Lupton. During our whole class reading lessons we will be reading "Who Let the Gods Out" by Maz Evans

**Writing:** In order to become inspired writers, we will be learning to write a range of genres to include informal letters, flashbacks and film narratives. We will maintain our focus on revising the key skills of spelling, punctuation, grammar as well as selecting and using more adventurous vocabulary too.

**Maths:** To become marvelous mathematicians we will be covering topics such as place value, addition and subtraction, as well as division and multiplication. We will be following the online work based on White Rose materials as well as daily arithmetic skills.

**Science:** To enhance our scientific understanding, we will be learning about forces.

**RE:** Studying the topic of temptation and this will help us deepen our understanding of the different faiths of the world.

**PSHE:** To become more empathetic, we will have an on-going focus of 'Changing me' in these lessons.

**D&T:** The topic of architecture which will enhance our designing, making and evaluating skills.

**ART:** To improve our artistic abilities, we will learn about architecture, especially that of the Greeks.

**History:** We will deepen our knowledge of world history by studying the topic of the Ancient Greeks

**Geography:** Our knowledge of the wider world will be improved by learning about the geography of ancient Greece

**Computing:** To become more proficient with technology, we will learn about our online self.

**French:** Learning about pets. This will help us become more bilingual.

**Music:** To enhance our musical talents, we will be looking at rock music and appraising songs such as Livin' on a Prayer and Smoke on the Water.
