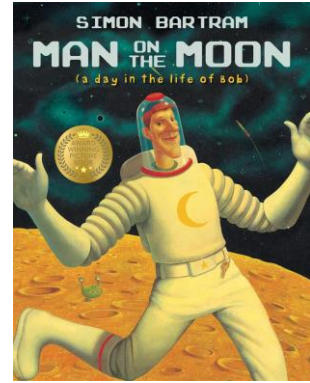




# YEAR 1 AUTUMN TERM 2



## Autumn - Second half term curriculum

**Reading:** A range of genre from fiction and non-fiction texts based on our space topic.

Main class text: *Man on the Moon* by Simon Bartram.

**Writing:** Continue to punctuate sentences with capital letters, full stops and finger spaces. Change short to compound sentence, using conjunction *and*. All leading to a non-chronological report based on information about the Moon.

**Maths:** Read, write and interpret mathematical statements involving addition (+) subtraction (-) and equals (=) signs. Add and subtract one digit numbers to 10, including 0. Recognise, name and sort 2-D and 3-D shapes.

**Science:** The seasons and related weather. Investigate seasonal changes and impact on environment. Devise and use a weather report to record weather daily throughout a month.

**Religious Education:** Special stories for Christians and Muslims - what can we learn. A look into the sacred texts of Christianity and Islam to discover why these books matter most in the religions they are learning about.

**Personal, Social and Health Education:** Celebrating difference - accepting everyone is different, including all in work and play, know how to give and receive compliments.

**Design and Technology:** Designing spaceships.

**ART:** Space themed work based on Space work by Peter Thorne.

**History:** Significant people from the past - Neil Armstrong. Research and create timeline of events related to space.

**Computing:**

**French:** Learning numbers 1-10, days of the week, colours and simple everyday speech.

**Music:** Lessons based around two songs, Rhythm in the way we walk and Banana Rap. Preparing for our Nativity performance.
