**History:** We will deepen our knowledge of world history by studying the journey of the Titanic.

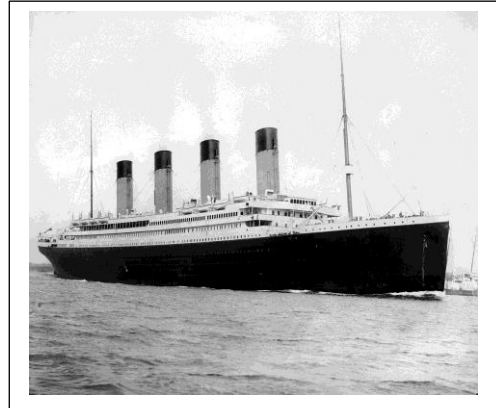
**Geography:** Our knowledge of the wider world will be improved by learning about America.
