## Autumn-First half term Curriculum

**Reading:** A range of genres from fiction and non-fiction texts including poetry. Our class story book is *Goodnight Mister Tom* written by Michelle Magorian.

**Writing:** A range of writing genres to include recounts, informal and formal letters, poetry and narratives with flashbacks.

**Maths:** Place value, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division following the online work based on White Rose materials as well as daily arithmetic skills.

**Science:** Learning based on the topic of forces.

**Religious Education:** Examining what we can learn from different religions about temptation.

**Personal, Social and Health Education:** On going focus: Being me in my world.

**Design Technology:** Designing and making wartime food.

**ART:** Exploring artwork using silhouettes.

**History:** Key events during the Second World War.


**Geography:** Discovering the location of countries involved in the Second World War.
