YEAR 6 AUTUMN TERM

We are going to explore the Amazon rain forest!

Reading: To discover where reading will take us, our class story book is "Stormbreaker" written by Anthony Horowitz. During our whole class reading lessons we will be reading "The Explorer" by Katherine Rundell.

Writing: In order to become inspired writers, we will be learning to write a range of genres to include non-chronological reports, setting descriptions and a diary entry. We will maintain our focus on revising the key skills of spelling, punctuation, grammar as well as selecting and using more adventurous vocabulary too.

Maths: To become marvellous mathematicians we will be covering topics such as place value, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division as well as fractions. We will be following the online work based on White Rose materials as well as daily arithmetic skills.

Science: To enhance our scientific understanding, we will be learning about our circulatory system including the heart and lungs.

RE: Studying the topic of 'religion and the individual: exploring commitment' will help us deepen our understanding of the different faiths of the world.

PSHE: To become more empathetic, we will have an on-going focus of 'Being Me in My World' in these lessons.

ART: To improve our artistic abilities, we will learn about painting and mixed media through an artist study of Henri Rousseau.

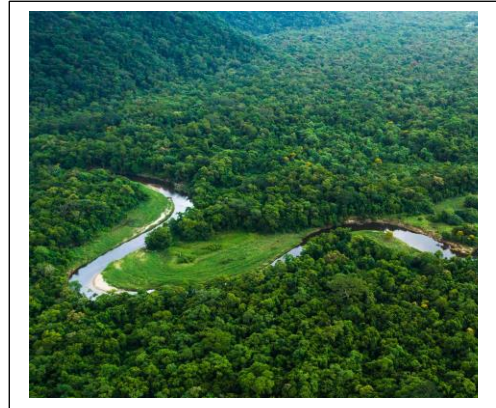
Geography: Our knowledge of the wider world will be improved by learning about why the rainforests are important to us.
